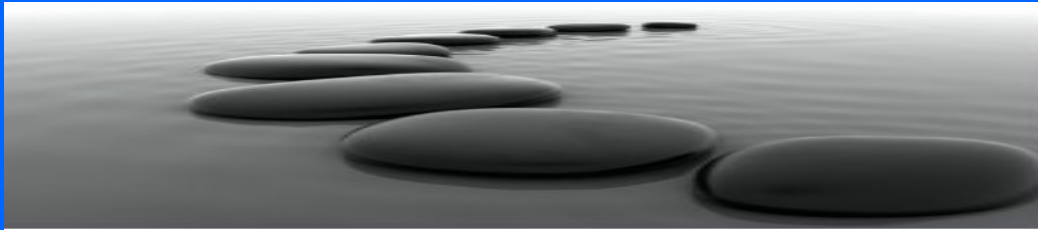




Staying on Track - A Workshop with Nan Carle
