



Supported Living - Train the Trainer

This is the only course of its kind in the UK. It is specifically aimed at people who already have some personal experience of implementing Supported Living and who wish to have a framework for incorporating their experiences into a training course which helps promote Supported Living and develop a broader understanding.

This course will teach delegates how to train people in Supported Living. The course will be led by Paula Daley and incorporate the combined experience of Paula and Paradigm's other consultants who have significant experience in the whole range of issues related to delivering Person Centred Supports. Each course is identical.

Context

The White Paper, and Scottish Review, strongly promote Person Centred approaches and Supported Living, in particular. If services are to respond to these demanding expectations, they will need to develop strong internal capacity to spread their early learning.

This course seeks to give organisations an opportunity to do this around Supported Living.

Who it's for

The course is only for people (whatever their position or role) who are actively involved (or have been) in setting up, running or promoting Supported Living. The purpose of the course is to give these people a framework to teach others about Supported Living, drawing upon their own personal experiences as well as the course content. Does this mean me? - If you can tell the story of a person who is supported to successfully live in their own home through the supported living model, then probably yes! There are only 16 places on each course, to ensure intensive tuition and maximum learning, so please book early.
