Personal Futures Planning Workbook book for each participant at the cost £25

This one day course is designed to enable participants to learn about the Person Centred Planning tool Personal Futures Planning - a tool based around understanding who the person is and what's important to them, and then looking at ways for the person to connect with their community. The basis of this planning style is a personal portfolio with information about the person and their hopes and desires for the future. People are then supported to develop maps that look at community, relationships, background, choices etc. The day should be accompanied with the Person Centred Planning Facilitators Values and Approaches course (1 day).

FEATURES

- This course gives an introduction to Personal Futures Planning as Person Centred Planning process.
- Participants will explore the structure of the tool.
- It provides an opportunity to explore personal portfolio building and relevant maps.
- This is a very flexible tool and allows people to develop a plan that works for them by including sections that make sense and leaving out others which don't.

- An understanding of the fundamental values that underpin Person Centred Planning.
- An understanding of the Personal Futures Planning process.
- An understanding of the benefits of the Personal Futures Planning process.
