This one day course is designed to enable participants to learn about the Person Centred planning tool MAPS. Which was first used as a tool to include people with disabilities into mainstream schools. MAPS starts by supporting the person to describe their story on their terms. MAPS also looks at peoples' dreams (of what a good life would look like) and also their nightmares (how life would look if it all went pear shaped). A major focus of MAPS is looking at the gifts people bring to their relationships and to their community. The training includes the practical experience of facilitating a MAP.

FEATURES

- This course gives an introduction to process facilitation and graphic facilitation
- It offers the experience of taking part in facilitating a MAP and / or experiencing you own MAP.
- The day should be accompanied with the Person Centred Planning Facilitators Values and Approaches course (1 day).
