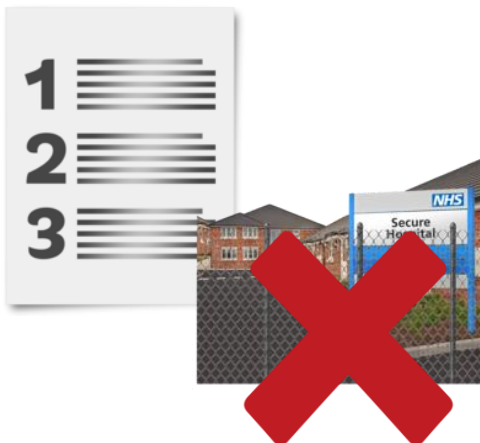
Can you give feedback on the plan for good community mental health support?

The Building the Right Support Plan

The government have a plan to stop people with a learning disability or autism being kept in hospital or a treatment unit because of the way they have behaved.



The plan is about how all parts of the government and NHS work better to help people get good support in the community.
