A little about Rose and CASCAIDr

Rosemary Trustam, who died in 2020, was the publisher of Community Living magazine, a relentless, unstoppable campaigner, an indomitable and determined fighter for the rights of people with Learning Disabilities, a force to be reckoned with and a real hero of the Learning Disability Community, who saw the magazine as an important part of the mission to achieve equality and inclusion.



Rose Trustam was also a valued director of CASCAIDr Trading Ltd, the trading arm of CASCAIDr - the specialist social care legal advice charity. Her input helped the charity to build a firm basis for growth, before Covid entered our consciousness. The pandemic meant that the charity had to reshape its advice offer, even to survive, and focus merely on Triage – a free steer for people with legal issues, rather than full-on casework, whether for free, or for a low-cost charge.

Rose's untimely and sad death, in 2020, meant that we cannot share our exciting news with her that CASCAIDr will be re-opening to chargeable work once again with an operations manager in charge, in February 2022.

In celebration of this good news re: CASCAIDr, and Rose's life and work, Belinda Schwehr, CASCAIDr's CEO, will present this event on people's rights to adult social care.
